MainPower - My Housing Expo

MainPower My Housing Expo will be held at Kaiapoi High School on Ohoka Road on Saturday 10 December from 12 noon - 6pm and Sunday 11 December from 10am - 4pm. The Expo, sponsored by MainPower and organised by Waimakariri District Council with the support of Enterprise North Canterbury and Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Authority (CERA), will provide an opportunity for people to learn about residential opportunities in Kaiapoi and the wider Waimakariri district, and source information about building and buying, insurance, finance and banking.

There will be 45 organisations on site both days at the expo, including local property developers and housing companies, banks and insurance companies. The Waimakariri District Council, CERA and the Earthquake Commission (EQC) will also be present. A number of topical seminars will be presented on Saturday and Sunday and these will cover insurance, land assessments, green building, financial considerations, building a house post-earthquake and legal issues associated with your property. A programme for the expo seminars will be printed in the Northern Outlook, North Canterbury News, Kaiapoi Advocate and The Press during the week commencing Monday 5 December.

The main focus for the expo is to provide the best information and advice for red zone homeowners in Kaiapoi, Pines Beach and Kairaki, as well as people who are thinking about living north of the Waimakariri River.
